

Ordinance 07-3

An Ordinance Requiring Address Numbers
Within the Village of South Point Be Displayed
And Declaring An Emergency

Whereas, not all homes and businesses within the Village of South Point are displaying their street address number on their properties, and

Whereas, emergency personnel may not be able to locate a property quickly due to the lack of house and business address numbers not being prominently displayed

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the South Point Village Council, that:


Section 1. ALL homes and businesses within the Village of South Point's corporation limits shall display their street address number so it is easily visible from their street.

Section 2. All numbers shall be four (4) inches tall and a color that is easily visible.

Section 3. Any legislation in conflict with this ordinance including ordinance 83-17 and ordinance 17-A is hereby repealed and void.

Section 4. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the health, safety and welfare of Village residents and shall take effect the earliest period allowed by law.
