

ORDINANCE 10-02

An Ordinance Amending Sanitation Monthly
Customer Billing Charges For The Village of
South Point and Declaring an Emergency

Whereas, Ordinance 09-16 has been previously adopted by the Village of South Point, Ohio and provides therein for fees to be charged for trash and garbage collection within the Village, and

Whereas, Section two, paragraph 14 states; Negotiations to increase the fees shall be considered by the Village only in the event that the same are occasioned by increases in cost for landfill services to the franchisee.

Whereas, The following ordinances have previously increased the monthly fees in accordance with paragraph 14 of Ordinance 09-16:

Ordinance 92-17 raised \$0.40 per residence = \$6.90 per month eff. 7/1/1992

Ordinance 02-13 raised \$0.50 per residence = \$7.40 per month eff. 1/1/2003

Ordinance 05-02 raised \$0.50 per residence = \$7.90 per month eff. 1/1/2005

Ordinance 06-07 raised \$0.50 per residence = \$8.40 per month eff. 6/1/2006

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of South Point, Ohio:

Section 1. Commencing January 1, 2010, the fee per residence shall be increased by \$1.00 per month making a total charge per residence of \$9.40 per month.

Section 2. This ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure in that prompt and efficient disposal of trash and garbage is necessary to protect the public health and shall be effective immediately upon passage with said rates being effective on and after January 1, 2010.
