

ORDINANCE 16-05

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 97-12 Revising
The Rates for Sewer Taps For The South Point
Sewer District and Declaring an Emergency

Whereas: the South Point Village Council deems it necessary to adjust the cost to install certain sewer taps

Now Therefore Be It Ordained, by the Council of the Village of South Point, Lawrence County, Ohio:


SECTION 1. Section IV, Paragraph (3) reading as follows:

"Paragraph (3) - Tap-in Charge Schedule"


When undeveloped lots located inside South Point Sewer District are improved by the construction of a residential dwelling or other buildings thereon to be served by the sewer system, the following tap-in charges shall be paid before any permit or authorization to connect to the sewer system is given. Tap-in fee shall be One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,750.00) per lot up to a 20' lateral and then \$40.00 per foot for additional pipe and labor needed.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and surrounding areas served by South Point Utilities and shall be in force immediately upon suspension of the 3 reading rule and passage by three fourths vote of Council.
