

ORDINANCE NO. 89-2

PROHIBITING CERTAIN ADVERTISING  
ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND AFFIXING PENALTY

WHEREAS, the Village of South Point has power to regulate the case of public property and such regulation is desirable, Now therefore be it ordained by said Village of South Point Council,

SECTION ONE: No person shall display political advertising upon public property or rights of way of the Village of South Point. Political advertising shall mean printed or typed material urging the support or defeat of a person or issue placed upon the ballot at an election conducted by the Lawrence County, Ohio, Board of Elections.

SECTION TWO: A fine of up to \$25.00 and costs may be imposed for each separate piece of literature displayed contrary to this ordinance.

SECTION THREE: Said ordinance shall be in force effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
