

ORDINANCE NO. 96-8

PROVIDING FOR A CURFEW FOR MINOR CHILDREN
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERE-
WITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH POINT,
COUNTY OF LAWRENCE AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION ONE: No person shall permit any minor under the age of eighteen to be on any street, sidewalk or other public place of the Village between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. unless such minor is accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the legal care, custody or control of such minor or is in the company of a responsible adult person twenty-one years of age or older who has permission from such parent or guardian to have such minor out during such hours.

SECTION TWO: It shall be the duty of any parent, guardian or other person having the care, control or custody of a minor under the age of eighteen to keep such minor off the streets, sidewalks or other public places of the Village between the hours specified in section one hereof, unless such minor is accompanied by such parent, guardian or other responsible adult person twenty-one years of age or older who has permission from such parent or guardian to accompany such minor.

SECTION THREE: Whoever violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION FOUR: All ordinances including Ordinance No. 1-A which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village.
