

Ordinance 98- 9

An Ordinance Concerning The Vacation of Village Owned Property and Declaring an Emergency


Whereas, it is necessary to establish guidelines regarding the vacation of property owned by the Village of South Point.

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of South Point, Ohio:

Section 1. The Village will no longer vacate any public property, roadway, alley, easement or right of way for any purpose unless such a vacation would benefit the majority of the residents of the village.

Section 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon suspension of the 3 reading rule and passage by a three-fourths vote of council
