SOUTH POINT, Ohio (WSAZ) - One bridge is getting a new name in honor of a long-time mayor.

The U.S. 52 bridge overpass on Solida Road in South Point, Ohio will now be called the "William A. Gaskin Bridge."

City officials held a ribbon cutting Sunday afternoon to solidify Gaskin's place in South Point's history.

William Gaskin has been the mayor of South Point since 1979 - and now he will be immortalized in the city forever now that the bridge bears his name.
