SOUTH POINT, Ohio (WSAZ) - Boy Scout Troop 115 invited the community to join them Sunday afternoon to honor local Veterans.

TJ Beavers, who is a Senior Patrol Leader with the troop, raised \$6,000 to have the monument built. Beavers says he got the money by speaking to various groups in the community about how he and his troop wanted to honor Veterans.
