

Ordinance 11-09

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 09-07
Adopting the Water Quality Ordinance Pertaining
To Stormwater for the Village of South Point
And Declaring an Emergency

Whereas, The Storm Water Task Force and the Lawrence County Commissioners have voted to increase the fees on all plan submittals required in Chapter 1 of Ordinance 09-07.

Whereas, The Village of South Point desires to have the same Storm Water Management Program as Lawrence County.

Now, Therefore the South Point Village Council hereby amends Ordinance 09-07, Chapter 1, Section 1.6 FEES to:

1.6. FEES.

All plan submittals required in Chapter 1 of ordinance 09-07 shall be accompanied by a fee payable in cash or by check to "Lawrence County" according to the following schedule at the time of initial submittal:


- 1) For developments involving one or more acres shall be \$200.00 per acre.

In addition to the fees set forth above, the plan reviewer, before issuing such a permit may charge and collect a penalty in every case where work or development otherwise covered by this resolution has actually commenced prior to the issuance of a permit according to the following schedule:


- 1) For developments involving one (1) but less than five (5) acres the penalty shall be \$500.00 for each day of noncompliance. (Days that work or development is in operation.)
- 2) For developments involving five (5) or more acres the penalty shall be \$1000.00 for each day of noncompliance. (Days that work or development is in operation.)

This ordinance is an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
